**Description:**

We invite Hudson County artists and residents to submit artwork for an online art auction fundraiser. We seek any available art from your collection to donate.

Alternatively, **we seek works of art that reflect the theme: *Holiday Wreaths, Full of Hope***. We hope to cultivate feelings of joy for the 2020 holiday season and evoke strong feelings of hope for 2021. We're open to your interpretation of this theme, using your choice of media, style and technique. This might be an evergreen wreath embellished in the time-honored traditional approach with holiday décor or in your own personal style. On the other hand, you are welcome to work in another medium—photography, collage, quilting and 3D printing for example. We're excited to see the varied selection this theme will inspire.

All artwork submissions will be donations to the Barrow Mansion and auctioned in an online fundraising event. This **Holiday 2020 Fundraiser** will help support upkeep of the Barrow Mansion. 100% of proceeds from the event will go to the Barrow Mansion.

The **Barrow Mansion** is a Greek Revival-style building (1837) located in the Van Vorst Historic District of Jersey City, New Jersey. Initially constructed as a private residence, the building has been in public use since 1890, when it became the Jersey City YMCA. The property was purchased by St. Matthew's Evangelical Lutheran Church in 1897.
